

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
 - WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
 - WHEREAS, the Coalition of Indian Controlled School Board is undertaking a juvenile delinquency assessment on ten reservations; and
 - WHEREAS, the Fort Berthold Reservation has been selected as one of the ten sites for the research; and
 - WHEREAS, the project will be for a three year period with local staff selected to conduct personal interviews; and
 - WHEREAS, the Coalition of Indian Controlled School Boards juvenile delinquency project is the first attempt made to conduct research among Indian tribes; and
 - WHEREAS, the project findings will be beneficial in planning for youth programs; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the Coalition of Indian Controlled School Boards to conduct research on juvenile delinquency on the Fort Berthold Reservation over a three year period.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
