

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Business Council's Judiciary Committee that the purchase of patches for the Fort Berthold Reservation Police Department would serve to identify the Police Department with the Reservation they serve; and

WHEREAS, it is the wish of the Captain of the Fort Berthold Police Department to wear the patch as originally designed; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council hereby recommends purchase of 160 loom run patches at \$329.60 and 30 American Flag emblems at .55¢ each totaling \$346.10; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said patches and emblems be purchased through Bureau of Indian Affairs' IMPL funds.
