RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, it has been brought of the attention of the Judiciary Committee that vehicles utilized by the Reservation's police staff are mechanically unfit and in need of replacement, and
- WHEREAS, dependable vehicles are necesary maintenance of efficient police patrol due to the Reservation's estensive size and severe climatic conditions, and
- WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes wish to provide the most efficient police safety and police protection for the Reservation communities, and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council will seek funding from Indian Monies Proceeds of Labor, BIA for four (4) fully equipped police at a cost of about \$8,000 per vehicle, or less, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Chairperson BIA Police Captain will be responsible to advertised for said cars to reputable dealers in North Dakota whereby best possible cost can be obtained.
