

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS. This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes WHEREAS. and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws, Section 2(b) provides for absentee ballots to be sent to enrolled non-resident members of the Tribes upon request made to Tribal Secretary by ten (10) days before the election; and

WHEREAS, The Election Ordinance, Part III Section 1(b) provides for return of all affidavits no less then forty-five (45) days prior to the election and Part VII, Section 1(a) provides fore requests for absentee at least (45) days before the election; and

Absentee voters are affected by the change to (45) days in the Election WHEREAS, Ordinance, and the change to (45) days is in conflict with the Constitution and By-laws; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Part III, Section 1(b) shall be changed from forty-five (45) days to ten (10) days and Part VII, Section 1(a) shall be amended from forty-five (45) days to ten (10) days to comply with Section 2(b) of the Constitution and By-laws.

## CERTIFICATION
