## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Point Source Assessment of the Fort Berthold 208 Areawide Water Planning Study has established that there are waste water deficiencies occurring within communities on the Fort Berthold Reservation and that there needs to be a program to alleviate these deficiencies; and
- WHEREAS, Under the terms of the Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.), the United States of America has authorized the making of grants to authorized applicants to aid in the construction of specific public projects.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Planning Department is hereby directed to execute and file an application on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation with the United States Government for a grant to aid in the preparation of the "Step I Facility Plan for the Rehabilitation of the Indian Community Wastewater Facility Systems.
- FURTHER RESOLVED, That Mary Schoppert, Housing and Tribal Facilities Planner, is designated as contact person for the project and is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration may reasonably request in connection with such application.
