RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority of said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Mandaree Water System and Utilities Commission are stated as being self supporting; and
- WHEREAS, since the addition of the Mandaree Water Line the problem of delinquent utility bills is high; and
- WHEREAS, the monies derived from utility bills is used to pay salaries of Utilities Commission personnel and maintenance of the Four Bears Water System; and
- WHEREAS, the installation of water meters would give an accurate account of what rates should be assessed per household and other establishments who use the water systems; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, after the installation of the water meters, delinquent utility bills shall be sent first request for payment and after two months delinquent account shall be sent shut off notice. until paid and when utility bill is paid a hook-up will be added; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, after installation of water meters, any accounts not current shall not have their water turned on until paid.
