WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, on October 30,1980 , the Three Affiliated Tribes were visited by United States Senator Quentin Burdick; and

WHEREAS, in order to prepare for Senator Burdick's visit a luncheon was planned; and
WHEREAS, DCPTI staff, Louella Young Bird and Norma Staples purchased luncheon supplies in the amount of $\$ 38.65$ and are requesting reimbursement; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes reimbursment of $\$ 29.00$ to Louella Young Bird and $\$ 9.65$ to Norma Staples, from Miscellaneous funds.
