

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Three Affiliated Tribes has within their Constitution and Bylaws a provision describing criteria for Dual Enrollment (Article II, Section 2(A), and
- WHEREAS, Article II, Section 2(A) language needs to be more clearly defined, and
- WHEREAS, the proper procedure for defining the above section would be to do so by adding a defining section to the Enrollment Ordinance by council resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes does hereby approve of adding the following defining section to their enrollment ordinance as follows:

"Section 4. Individuals who were ever enrolled with another tribe and received benefits from such tribe even though they relinquished membership from other tribe would not be eligible for membership in accordance with with Article II, Section 2(A) of the Tribal Constitution and By-laws."

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
