

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Business Council that the present curfew ordinance is inadequate, in that, it does not designate a curfew violation as a delinquent act; and

WHEREAS, it is important in the implementation of the Juvenile Code that curfew violation are deemed to be delinquent acts;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the following paragraph be added to the curfew ordinance:

"that should a juvenile be in violation of the curfew ordinance said act may be deemed to be a delinquent act upon proper determination by the juvenile court system."
