

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes has the responsibility to provide for effective Juvenile Judicial Services on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Indian Reservation currently has an active Juvenile Clerk with no Juvenile Judge and there is a substantial increase of Juvenile Cases in the Tribal Court; and
- WHEREAS, The current Fort Berthold Juvenile Code requires additional work that the Chief Judge does not have time to hear due to his regular cases, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby grant a Juvenile Judge position that will incorporate with the Juvenile Clerk position and the position shall be the Juvenile Judge/Juvenile Clerk position in the Criminal Justice Program.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
