## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, there now appears to be an outstanding bill in the amount of \$691.73 owed by the Youth Conservation Corp (YCC) to the Farmer's Union Oil Company; and
- WHEREAS, this bill appeared after the 1979 contract was closed out thereby discontinuing the availability of funds for this bill from the YCC contract; and
- WHEREAS, the outstanding bill causes problems for other programs using the same vendor; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes payment of the outstanding bill owed by YCC program in the amount of \$691.73 from the T/2 account to be to the Farmer's Union Oil Company, New Town, North Dakota; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Program Directors who do not use the purchase order system of Property & Supply will be personally liable for their purchases.
