

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the roads and ditches in the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation are cluttered with debris (broken glass, cans, boards, etc.) resulting in physical hazard to joggers, hitchhikers, animals, etc., and

WHEREAS, the danger of a tire rupturing causing potential death to the lives of all motorists and because unkept roads present a less than desirous view of the Tribal Government.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Tribal Court may have alternative sentencing authority to order a prisoner to:

- 1.) Clean up the roads and ditches in the Fort Berthold Reservation under the supervision of the daytime jailer or other responsible persons of a tribal program.
- 2.) To help any and all tribal programs that need help.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aluminum cans shall be kept for recycling and that all prisoners will not work outdoors in inclement weather.


