

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes requires a security bond for all permittees for allocation of grazing privileges on tribal lands; and
- WHEREAS, Permittees who are clients of the Farmer's Home Administration often borrow money to pay this bond in addition to money to finance their operations; and
- WHEREAS, It would be in the best financial interests of these permittees to waive the security bond requirement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Business Council, that Grazing Resolution #80-155, Part 2 Section F(10) be amended: the security bond requirement is hereby waived for Farmer's Home Administration Clients; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these permittees are hereby required to pay their grazing lease fees on or before November 1 of each year;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there will be no exceptions made for extension of payment.
