

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council authorizes all board memberships for example, Wahpeton Indian School Board, Pierre Indian Learning Center, North Dakota Indian Affairs Commission, Council of Energy Resource Tribes, United Tribes, etc.; and
- WHEREAS, These organizations pay for Tribal Council members travel, per diem, and lodging expenses; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes shall pay for Tribal Council members travel and per diem for tribal representation to National Congress of American Indians, National Tribal Chairmen's Association and any workshops or conference; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council authorizes all board memberships; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tribal Council members travel and per diem shall be paid for by the Tribe for tribal representation to NCAI, NTCA and any workshops or conferences.
