

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1894, and authority under said Act: and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, . . . The general public acknowledges the dangers of alcoholism and drugs through a nationally recognized Alcoholism and Drug Awareness week, and

WHEREAS, . . . The Fort Berthold Reservation needs to give this same recognition to curb the increased use of alcohol and drugs locally, and

WHEREAS, . . . A tribally recognized Alcohol and Drug Awareness Week would provide an added opportunity for tribally administered alcoholism program to impact local schools and communities through awareness programs.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, . . . That January 10-14, 1983 be recognized as Alcohol and Drug Awareness Week for the Fort Berthold Reservation.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N


