

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 authorizes the Secretary of Interior to make grants to Indian Tribes for the establishment of Indian Child and Family Services; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Child Welfare Program has been functioning for the past four years with significant annual financial support; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes wishes to make the Child Welfare Program a more efficient, highly respected entity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes under the authority of Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for financial assistance in the amount of \$101,568.00 for the Child Welfare Program for a one year period, beginning July 1, 1982.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, or Treasurer of the Three Affiliated Tribes shall be allowed to negotiate and sign on behalf of the Tribal Business Council.



The Three Affiliated Tribes hereby submits the proposal under Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 for financial assistance for the operations of the Child Welfare Program.

The program provides a comprehensive emergency foster care services for the children of the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara tribes who have been neglected, abused, abandoned, or who have been termed predelinquent.

The program attempts to assure that the children are adequately nurtured as they progress through the developmental stages so that they can become responsible adults.

The Fiscal Year 1983 program is for a period of one year and the operational expenses the Tribe requests for is 101,568.00.

The application certifies that the data submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs are true and correct.
