

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation, having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority is under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorized and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes recognize that pesticide control is an important issue on the reservation and desire to provide for enforcement of the (FIFRA) on all lands within the boundaries of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes desires to provide for the control of pesticide use on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation through enforcement of the Three Affiliated Tribes Pesticide Code and FIFRA, as amended.

WHEREAS, The Natural Resources Department's Land Operations Division and Tribal Ranger Division propose to assist the Three Affiliated Tribes in the accomplishment of establishing a technically feasible Pesticide Code enforcement program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes contract with the EPA for a one-year contract for the continuation of the Pesticide Enforcement Program grant during Fiscal Year 1983.
