## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The KMHA Radio Station is behind construction schedule because there is no feasible site available in the line-of-sight designation for the studios; and
- WHEREAS, There is a 33 ft. diameter geodesic dome that was purchased for \$30,000 with Tribal £unds in 1980; and
- WHEREAS, The dome has never been constructed since its purchase in 1980; and
- WHEREAS, Using the dome for Headstart children could pose serious safety problems with the stairs, making it unfeasible for handicapped and small children,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes Business Council redesignate the construction and use of the dome to the KMHA radio station; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That an ample amount of tribal land directly south of the Tribal Administration Building be authorized for use by the KMHA radio station to construct the dome, STL antenna and satellite dish.
