

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorize and empower the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The 94-437 scholarships are necessary to provide money to educate Indian youth in the health careers, and

WHEREAS, Section 104 of this scholarship program insures that their students will serve Indian people, and

WHEREAS, The health status of Indian people is directly affected by the lack of Indian health professionals, and

WHEREAS, There has been a proposed phase out of the Scholarships Program and INMED,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes request continuation of Indian Health Care Improvement Scholarships Section 103 and 104 with the same level of new starts each year, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Tribal Business Council rejects the proposed phase out of this very necessary program and requests continuation of the INMED Program to reconcile this money to be cost effective as shown by INMED's track record.
