

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorize and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes has an obligation and concern to provide an adequate education for the Indian children attending public schools; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes has contracted to administer the Johnson O'Malley Program for Indian students attending school in the Fort Berthold Headstart Centers - \$7,920.00; Parshall School District #3 - \$12,210.00; and the New Town School System - \$41,580.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Johnson O'Malley Program contract for \$50,721.00 be renewed for the fiscal year, 1983, to continue the administration for the foregoing schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Johnson O'Malley contract be based upon the same terms and conditions of the act as established and carried out by the Aberdeen Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
