

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

FORT BERTHOLD PRE-SCHOOLER IMMUNIZATION MONTH

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorize and empower the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, September, 1982 has been called "North Dakota Pre-Schooler Immunization Month" by Governor Allen Olson; and
- WHEREAS, Indian Health Service's objective is to reach 90% immunization level for pre-schoolers in September, 1982; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Business Council supports the Indian Health Service initiative of 90% immunization level for all pre-schoolers,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Mr. Austin H. Gillette, Chairman of the Three Affiliated Tribes, hereby declares September, 1982 as Fort Berthold Pre-Schooler Immunization Month; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes Business Council encourages all mothers of pre-schoolers to update their child's immunizations, appropriate for age, in September, 1982.
