

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
WHEREAS, The Tribe has the authority to regulate and license attorneys practicing in the Tribal Courts; and
WHEREAS, The fee schedule below shall apply retroactive to October 1, 1982; and
WHEREAS, All attorneys practicing before the Tribal Court shall be subject to rules governing conduct of the Courts, as adopted by the Tribal Judges; and
WHEREAS, The application shall require the attorney license applicant to submit to the jurisdiction of the Court, and agrees to abide by all rules of the Tribal Court. Violation of said rules is cause for revocation of an attorney license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the fee schedule below is hereby adopted:

- 1. Attorneys licensed to practice (in any jurisdiction) who have practiced :
 - A. 1 to 5 years shall pay a yearly license fee of forty dollars (\$40.00).
 - B. 5 years and up shall pay a yearly fee of eighty dollars (\$80.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said fee schedule set out above which allows licensed attorneys to practice in tribal court, shall supercede any and all prior provisions or laws on attorney license fees.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 11 members of whom 7 constitutes a quorum, 8 were present at a Special Meeting, thereof duly called, noticed, convened and held on the 22 day of October, 1982; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of 8 members, 0 members opposed, 0 members abstained, 0 members not voting and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
