**THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES**

- WHEREAS, This nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota is constructing a road south of New Town, ND on the Fort Berthold Reservation which is referred to as North Dakota Project #AHL-51 (S)
- WHEREAS, the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes are facing serious unemployment; and
- WHEREAS, a part of the funds for construction of the above road are contributed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior; and

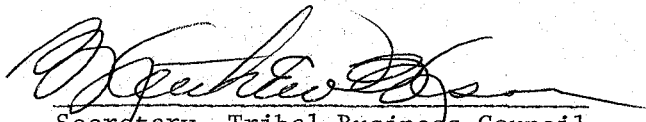
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Three Affiliated Tribes does hereby request that the above project be classified as a twenty per cent (20%) minority set-aside project by the State of North Dakota, and further that the Bureau of Indian Affairs assist the Three Affiliated Tribes in meeting this objective.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N

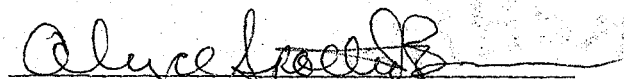
