## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEKEAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (j) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to protect and preserve the property, wildlife, and natural resources of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Three Affiliated Tribes has adopted the Fort Berthold Pesticides Code; and
- WHEREAS, It has been necessary to revise a limited amount of language therein, specifically the addition of the phrase "Resticted Use Pesticide" as requested by the Environmental Protection Agency, upon their review of the Code; and
- WHEREAS, The above-identified revisions have been made within the Code as requested by the Environmental Protection Agency;
- NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Three Aftiliated Tribes, Tribal Business Council hereby approves the Fort Berthold Pesticide Code as revised.
