WHEREAS, Attorneys, Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Wilder, Contract #A00C14201145 have submitted vouchers for payment of legal services of \$7,835.35 and legal expenses of \$1,507.17, incurred during during the months of October, November and December of 1982; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes payment of \$9,342.52 to Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Wilder, for legal services and legal expenses rendered for the months of October, November, December, 1982.
