RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the people of Fort Berthold are a people who hold the traditional value of respect for our Mother, Earth; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has been appointed for the responsibility of providing leadership for the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, communities located within the Reservation are in need of betterment and beautification; and

WHEREAS, such an event would: (1) encourage community involvement, (2) develop respect and consideration for community and neighbors and (3) build feelings of unity, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council declare the week May 1, through May 7, 1983, as Earth Day to focus on the objectives outlined.
