- WHEREAS, The Constituion and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empoweres the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Among those of our members who are self-employed in farming and ranching and other enterprises, there are a substaintial number who are indebted to the Farmers Home Administration and,
- WHEREAS, Due to the depressed agricultural economy of the present time some of these Indian FmHA clients are in danger of losing their operations, and livelihoods to FmHA foreclosure action, and
- WHEREAS, The Family Farm Foreclosure Legal Assistance Project, a statewide non-profit organization has initiated a class action lawsuit to initiate loan deferral and moratorium opportunities which will benefit Indian FmHA clients as well,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Three Affiliated Tribes
 Tribal Buisness Council hereby donates the sum of one
 thousand doallars to the Family Farm Foreclosure Legal
 AssistanceProject to help defray the expenses that will
 be incurred.
