WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes (hereinafter referred to as the "Tribes") currently have an agreement with the law firm of Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Wilder (hereinafter referred to as the "Attorneys") for said firm to act as attorneys to the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Attorneys have rendered vouchers for fees in the amount of \$17,264.20 and for expenses in the amount of \$3,492.01 which have not been paid, see attached Schedule of Vouchers Unpaid; and

WHEREAS, The Attorneys' work and expenses are in excess of the contract budgets, but were incurred in connection with projects approved by the Tribes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the vouchers shown on the attached Schedule of Vouchers Unpaid, totalling \$20,756.21, are approved for payment.
