

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act, and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes charges the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to protect and preserve the property, wildlife and natural resources of the Tribes, and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Natural Resources Department has managed an Environmental Quality Division, comprised of a Pesticides Enforcement Component and Air Quality Component for the past two years, and

WHEREAS, These Components have contributed greatly to the effectiveness of tribal government in protecting the health and welfare of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes also recognize the need for a component to investigate and protect drinking water sources on the Fort Berthold Reservation, and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes request that the Environmental Protection Agency continue to fund the two existing Environmental Quality Components and also the proposed Safe Drinking Water Component at the rates prescribed by the applicable regulations.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N


