- WHEREAS, The Pouch Point Bay Recreation Area needs a developed access road to provide for the development of the Recreation Area, and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs will have the road built with Access Highways to Lakes funding in conjunction with the paving of the loop road, and
- WHEREAS, This developed access road will provide income and jobs to the Tribe and its members, and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Council grant an easement across the attached, described Tribal land for the purpose of developing an access road to the Pouch Point Bay Recreation Area.




