

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE  
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR PRELIMINARY LOAN  
FOR LOW-RENT PUBLIC HOUSING

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1983, and authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, It is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and to realize, as soon as feasible, the goal of a decent home in a suitable living environment for all of its citizens; and
- WHEREAS, Under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is authorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of low-income housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and
- WHEREAS, The Act provided that there shall be local determination of need for low-income housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a public housing agency for loans for surveys and planning in respect to any low-income housing projects unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution approved the application of the public housing agency for such loan; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Housing Authority (herein called the "Local Authority") is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a loan to cover the costs of surveys, planning and development in connection with the development of low-income housing.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of Fort Berthold Reservation as follows:
1. That there exists in the Three Affiliated Tribes of Fort Berthold Reservation a need for such low-income housing which is not being met by private enterprise:
  2. That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for a loan in connection with an application for 20 low-income dwelling units is hereby approved.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N


Dear Mr. Dibella:
