- WHEREAS. This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and authority under said Act, and
- The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes charges WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to protect and preserve the property, wildlife and natural resources of the Tribes, and
- The proposed Southwest Pipeline will require an Environmental WHEREAS, Assessment prior to any actual construction activity, and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes has the majority of the technical capacity in place to perform an Environmental Assessment for the Southwest Pipeline project and has access to consultants to perform those tasks which the Department is unable to, and
- The Bureau of Indian Affairs has tentatively voiced their approval WHEREAS, of the the Natural Resources Department being the lead agency in undertaking an Environmental Assessment for the project, and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Bureau of Indian Affairs approve a contract for the amount of \$10,852.00, as authorized by Public Law 93-638, so the Natural Resources Department can promptly commence work on Environmental Assessment for the Southwest Pipeline project.
