RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, There is a severe housing shortage in the communities of White Shield and Mandaree; and
- WHEREAS, The two individuals who are currently filling the positions of Nurse Practitioner in those two communities need adequate housing for themselves and their families; and
- WHEREAS, They are currently living in Bureau of Indian Affairs housing, and wish to continue living there so they they may continue working in their capacity as Nurse Practitioners, a critical service to the communities; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The the Nurse Practitioners in the communities of White Shield and Manlaree be allowed to continue living in their present Bureau of Indian Affairs quarter, and not be forced to relocate, and that the Bureau of Indian Affairs turn over these quarters to the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council when they are completely renovated.
