WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and their enrolled members; and

- WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes, Tribal Business Council is concerned and committed to insuring adequate health support to the critically ill and the handicapped; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council support the Community Health Representative Services to obtain local housing for the two (2) Kidney Dialysis patients, Vincent Hunts Along Sr. and William Myrick Sr.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council went on record, November21, 1983 to authorize the Fort Berthold Housing Authority to make available two (2) appartments for the said above Kidney Dialysis patients.
