- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes desires to continue to contract the Statute of Limitations 2415 Indian Land Claims Project under the authority of P.L. 93-638; and
- WHEREAS, A proposal, and a supporting budget have been developed which are satisfactory to the Tribal Business Council;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes does hereby approve for submittal the attached proposal for P.L. 93-638 contract of the 2415 Indian Land Claims Project in FY/84 as presented; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That any Executive Committee member shall be allowed to negotiate and sign on behalf of the Tribal Business Council; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Natural Resources Department will administer the contract upon its receipt.
