RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Millard W. Hale, resident in Mandaree on the Fort Berthold Reservation and enrolled members of the Three Affiliated Tribes, propose to establish cable network television in the Mandaree, White Shield, and Four Bears Communities; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Hale have already commenced cable television surveys and have concluded that each of the three communities would be eligible under applicable criteria of a minimum of fifty (50) families that would agree to cable television in their homes;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby formally sanctions the proposed development of and the entrepreneurial effort of Mr. and Mrs. Millard W. Hale to complete the project.
