RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (i), of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to make assignments and leases of tribal lands; and
- WHEREAS, The following tracts of oil and gas mineral interests benefically owned by the Three Affiliated Tribes were bid on by oil companies in a lease sale on April 24 and 25, 1984, which was conducted in conformity with the regulations found in 25 C.F.R. Parts 211 and 212;

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council does not feel that the bonus consideration offered is adequate for the rights granted by an oil and gas lease on the abovementioned tracts; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has requested the Bureau of Indian Affairs to prepare and advertisement offering all of the unleased oil and gas minerals to the highest qualified bidder in a competitive oil and gas lease sale to be held this fall; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affilliated Tribes hereby rejects the aforementioned bids on the above listed tracts and requests the Superintendent of the Fort Berthold Agency to include them in the upcoming oil and gas lease sale advertisement.
