

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes, Article VI, Section 5j, Charges the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to protect and preserve the property, wildlife and natural resources of the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes, Tribal Business Council has expressed an interest in developing a limited number of key recreation areas, on Lake Sakakawea, to provide income and employment on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and

WHEREAS, The recreation development plan for Skunk Creek proposed by Jim Danks has been reviewed by the Natural Resources Department and the changes will be incorporated into a lease; and

WHEREAS, The Corps land that is contained in the proposal is currently in grazing status and will have to be changed to recreational status for development to occur; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council requests the Army Corps of Engineers to take the following Corps land, E1/2, Section 10, SE1/4 Section 3, T149N, R92W, approximately 208 acres below 1850', out of Public Law 87-695 grazing status and change the Corps master plan designation of the above described area to recreational use.
