## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (j), of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to protect and preserve the property, wildlife, and natural resources of the tribes; and
- WHEREAS, There is an acute problem with infestations of grasshoppers on rangeland on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Animal Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), at the request of the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), is willing to undertake a survey to determine the extent of the infestation and if necessary take measures to eradicate the pest;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby authorizes APHIS personnel to enter onto the Fort Berthold Reservation for the purpose of conducting the abovementioned survey.
