## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation, having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affilited Tribes authorize and empower the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribe and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Attorney Contract between the Tribe and Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker, dated January 1, 1978, was assigned to Charles A. Hobbs and Jerry C. Straus on September 30, 1982, and this was approved by the Tribe on October 27, 1982, and by the BIA on February 7, 1983, and said contract carried an expiration date of December 31, 1983, unless extended; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe, on December 8, 1983, extended the said contract for an additional two years, to December 31, 1985, and approved the change of name of the attorneys from Hobbs and Straus to its legal successor Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Wilder, which tribal action was approved by the BIA on February 16, 1984; and

- WHEREAS, The Tribe wishes to extend the said contract for another two years, to December 31, 1987; and
- WHEREAS, The Attorneys and the Tribe wish to change the amount of compensation under the contract from \$100 per attorney hour to \$105 per attorney hour and Robert J. Martin from \$60 to \$80.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the attached amendment to Par. 6 of Attorney Contract is hereby approved.

Dear Alyce:

As you know, our contract expires December 31. We enclose a draft resolution which extends our attorney contract with the Tribe for an additional two years, to December 31, 1987. We also enclose an amendment which increases the attorney hourly rate by five percent -- from \$100 per hour to \$105 per hour. The hourly rate for Robert J. Martin is increased to \$80 per hour. These increases are the first for several years, and are still well below our regular commercial rates.

Continuing the contract will not cost the Tribe anything. We will earn fees only when and as the Tribe assigns work to us with an agreed budget, which is our current arrangement.

Jerry Straus and I will be planning to visit several western clients in January, and we would like to stop by at Fort Berthold on January 9 or any other day when the Council can put us on the agenda. This would be at our expense, not the Tribe's.

## AMENDMENT TO ATTORNEY CONTRACT DATED JANUARY 1, 1978

Paragraph 6(b) is amended to read as follows:

"6. Compensation to the Attorneys shall be provided for as follows:

"(b) For all other services performed for the Tribes, including but not limited to legal work performed on the Fort Berthold Reservation or elsewhere while attorneys of the firm are on travel status, and including travel time for any round trips in excess of four per year as provided in subparagraph (a) of this paragraph, the Attorneys shall be entitled to fees at the rate of \$105 per hour for all partner and associate time, and up to half that rate for paralegal and law clerk time, and \$80 per hour for the time of Robert J. Martin until such time as he becomes a licensed attorney; provided, however, that the Tribes shall be entitled to no more than 300 hours per year from Robert J. Martin at the rate of \$80 per hour."
