- WHEREAS, Article IX, Section I of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to manage, lease, and otherwise deal with Tribal Lands; and
- WHEREAS, Gainus Little Soldier is requesting a right-of-way easment across Tribal Allotments (listed below) for a road easment of 75 ft.; and

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affilliated Tribes hereby approves the right-of-way easment for Gainus Little Soldier on said Tribal Allotments for ingress and egress and the Three Affiliated Tribes agrees to waive payment for rights granted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That when the Tribal Business Council determines rates for rights-of-way/easments, the applicable rate will be effective for the above right-of-way granted.
