

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes charges the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes to protect and preserve the property, wildlife and natural resources of the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Natural Resources Department, Game and Fish Division is in immediate need of funding for additional Tribal Ranger positions; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs Land Operations Department is not responsive to the Landowner and Lessee complaints on Land Operations problems; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes requests that the BIA begin working with the Natural Resources Department on contracting the Range Aide positions from the Bureau of Indian Affairs and any other funding available for use by the Game and Fish Division.
