WHEREAS,	The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
WHEREAS,	Article 6, section 5(1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies; and
WHEREAS,	employees and council members of the Three Affiliated Tribes have expressed the need and desire to implement a group retirement plan; and
WHEREAS,	the Tribal Personnel Office is proposing the development of an employee retirement plan whereby programs would contribute 2½% of total salaries to such a plan with an equal match being contributed by employees; and
NOW, THEREFO	ORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council authorize programs to budget for a $2\frac{1}{2}$ % contribution per employee to be paid toward a retirement fund; and
BE IT FURTH	ER RESOLVED that the retirment plan be implemented by October 1, 1986.
