## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Reservation schools are an important and integral part of our society; and
- WHEREAS, The concept of a free and equal education is an American tradition and this country's strength; and
- WHEREAS, The students of today are the leaders of tomorrow; and
- WHEREAS, All citizens have a responsibility to support the Tribal Reservation schools;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes do hereby proclaim November 16-22, 1986, as American Education Week and urge all citizens to make a commitment to education and to the future of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation children by visiting their local schools and by donating their time and talents to help make the schools even better.
