RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
OF THE
FORT EERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION
WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes frequently trade land or lease land to tribal members for homesites; and

WHEREAS, In several instances either no ground water or only ground water of unusable quality is found on the homesite; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds available for P. L. 93-638 contracts to Indian tribes for mineral assessments; and

WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes firmly believe that a P.L. 93-638 contract for a ground water assessment and inventory program would be of great benefit to the Tribe and tribal members.

NOW THEREFORE EE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to approve the Tribes proposal for a P.L. 93-638 contract for a ground water assessment and inventory program on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.
