WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council recognizes the Observance of Teacher Appreciation Week beginning May 3 and ending May 9, 1987 and the National Teacher Day, May 5, 1987.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council in observance of Teacher Appreciation Week and National Teacher Day recognizes all the teachers on the Fort Berthold Reservation for their dedication and contribution to the children and our communities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council thanks all the teachers of Headstart, our schools and the Community College for your dedicated effort, and you are appreciated as professional men and women dedicated to strengthening and building quality education for all residents of the Fort Berthold Reservation; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council recognizes your hard work resulting in our young people educated to reach their full potential is a MONUMENT TO YOUR EFFORTS AND WE NOW HONOR YOU ON THE NATIONAL TEACHER DAY AND THROUGHOUT YOUR CAREERS AS YOU GREET EACH STUDENT AND SHOULDERS THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF TEACHING.



TEACHER APPRECIATION WEEK PROCLAMATION



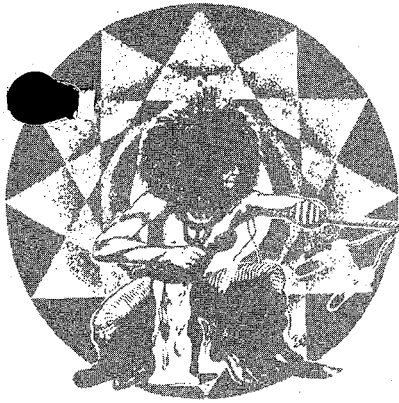
We honor you not only on the National Teacher Day but each day of the year as you greet each student and shoulder the responsibilities of teaching.
