

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes desires to contract under Public Law 93-638 for the following program funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Fiscal Years 1988, 1989, 1990:

Criminal Justice

- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs, in a letter dated June 18, 1987, requests that the Three Affiliated Tribes submit an application for FY-88 based on 75% and 100% of the tentative FY-88 allocations;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes under the authority of P.L. 93-638 will contract - for a three-year period beginning October 1, 1987 through September 30, 1990 - the Criminal Justice.
- FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer shall be allowed to negotiate and sign on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council.
