

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution and Bylaws of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes recognizes the need for community based economic development activities; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes is eligible to apply for BIA Economic Development Grants as a matching contribution for business development; and

WHEREAS, Mandaree, Inc. desires to pursue the Manceram Project as a community based enterprise;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes shall apply for a BIA Economic Development matching grant to be used in the formulation of a financing package for the Manceram business development project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all receipts and benefits derived from the BIA Economic Development Grant and the Manceram Project shall accrue solely to Mandaree, Inc.


C E R T I F I C A T I O N
