## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS. The Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council desires to do all things possible to assist the agricultural industry on the Fort Rerthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The lack of moisture during the past several months combined with the early high temperatures during May and June have significantly damaged the range, pasture, and crops of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Most of the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes who are engage in agriculture for their livelihood are already suffering economic hardships.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby declares the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation a drought area and acute distress area and hereby requests the Federal government to provide any and all types of relief possible to the agricultural operators of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.
