RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers "the Tribal" Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council will have \$90,000 available in the FY 1989 Docket 350-G Business Development Fund Category; and
- WHEREAS, \$40,000 of this FY 1989 Allocation is committed to a KMHA Loan Repayment; and
- WHEREAS, \$50,000 of this FY 1989 Allocation is committed to collateralizing a Loan being made by the Tribal Small Loan Program; and
- WHEREAS, It is anticipated that the Small Loan Program will have repaid its Loan by January of 1989; and
- WHEREAS, There will then be \$50,000 available for Business Development Loans at that time; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council is publishing guidelines for submitting loan applications for those funded.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Docket 350-G Business

 Development Fund Fiscal Year 1989 LOAN APPLICATION

 RULES are as follows:
 - 1. There will be a limit of \$5,000 per Project or Enterprise,
 - 2. The Loans must be collateralized with unencumbered Property such as real estate or chattel(s),
 - 3. The Loan application must include:
 - a. pro forma of the proposed business,
 - b. experience & qualifications of individual making the loan,

- c. provide schedule of repayment,
- d. provide title for the real estate or chattel(s) being used as collateral,
- e. provide evidence of matching funds to be used in the proposed project,
- f. provide project narrative describing business plan and marketing plan,
- g. proposals are due into the Tribal Office by January 1, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, existing businesses are immediately qualified but must also submit the required documentation identified in 1-3 above. The total allocation for loans to existing businesses shall not exceed \$25,000. The \$5,000 maximum loan limit per business shall remain.
